WHEREAS, the owner(s) of all property within the territory proposed for annexation have given their written consent by notarized petition so that a referendum is not NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Tennessee Board of Mayor and Alderman of the Town of Woodbury, Tennessee that: pursuant to the provisions of Section 6-51-102, *Tennessee Code Annotated*, there is hereby adopted for the above mentioned property, the following "Plan of Services" as studied by and certified to, required; and WHEREAS, a copy of this Resolution, describing the territory proposed for the Board of Mayor and Alderman of Woodbury, Tennessee by the Woodbury Municipal Planning Commission meeting in regular session on November 19, annexation, was promptly sent by the Town of Woodbury to the last known address listed in the office of the property assessor for each property owner of record within the territory proposed for annexation, with such being sent by first class mail and mailed no later than **fourteen (14) calendar** days prior to the scheduled date of the hearing on the proposed annexation by owner consent; and Patrolling, radio responses to calls, and other routine police services, using present personnel and equipment, will be provided immediately on the (1) WHEREAS, this Resolution was also published by posting copies of it in at least three (3) public places in the territory proposed for annexation and in a like number of public places in the Town of Woodbury, and by publishing notice of the Resolution at or about the same time in the *The Cannon Courier*, a newspaper of general circulation in such territory and the Town of Woodbury; and effective date of annexation. WHEREAS, the proposed annexation and Plan of Services were submitted to the Woodbury Municipal Planning Commission for study, and it has recommended the same; Water main lines, which are currently provided to the property by the Woodbury Water Department, service will continue to be provided subject to the policies and practices of the Woodbury Water Department. In WHEREAS, notice of the time, place and purpose of a public hearing on the proposed annexation and the Plan of Services was published in a newspaper of general circulation in the Town of Woodbury not less than fifteen (15) days before the hearing, which notice included the locations of a minimum of three (3) copies of the Plan of Services instances when water main lines are not available, it shall be the responsibility of the property owner or developer requesting annexation to install all necessary water lines at their expense. If these lines meet the standards or policies of the water department and capacity will not be for public inspection during all business hours from the date of notice until the public hindered, service will be provided immediately and the lines shall be taken over by the water department.
